About ASFA Life Membership

ASFA Life Membership is the Association's highest individual honour. It recognises an individual whose exceptional and sustained service to ASFA, the superannuation industry, or both, has made a significant and lasting contribution.

Life Membership is reserved for a small number of individuals whose service, influence and commitment have had an enduring impact on ASFA or Australia's superannuation system.

Nomination threshold

A nominee must demonstrate exceptional and sustained service to ASFA, the superannuation industry, or both, resulting in a significant and lasting contribution.

Pathways for recognition

Service to ASFA	Service to the superannuation industry
A substantial contribution to the work, development or community of ASFA. This may include service through governance, committees, working groups, discussion groups, policy and advocacy, professional learning, events or other member initiatives.	A substantial contribution to the development, strength or effectiveness of Australia's superannuation system. This may include public policy, industry practice, governance, professional standards, research, education, collaboration, innovation, inclusion, sector capability or outcomes for members.

How nominations will be assessed

- the depth, duration and consistency of the nominee's contribution
- the significance and lasting impact of their service
- the breadth of benefit to ASFA, the superannuation community or the wider system
- the extent to which the contribution has extended beyond the nominee's role or the interests of a single organisation
- their contribution to collaboration, knowledge-sharing and the development of others
- their professional standing and the regard in which their contribution is held

Assessment is holistic. A nominee does not need to demonstrate every consideration. ASFA Fellowship, formal leadership positions and service in ASFA governance or member groups may support a nomination but are not mandatory.

- Under the ASFA Constitution, an individual may be elected as a Life Member only by resolution passed at an Annual General Meeting.
- Any Board recommendation must be sent to ASFA members with the notice convening the AGM at which the resolution will be considered.
- An elected Life Member may subsequently be formally recognised at the ASFA Conference.
